

Buddha Akshobhya (Mitrugpa) Mantra lyrics:

"Namo bhagavate Akṣhobhāya, tathāgatāyārhate saṃyaksaṃbuddhyāya.

Tadyathā: Om kamkani kamkani. Rochani rochani.

Troțani troțani. Trāsani trāsani. Pratihana pratihana.

Sarva karma paramparāņime sarva sattvānañcha svāhā."

Bija mantra: Om Akshobhya Hum

Akshobhya is one of the five Dhyani Buddhas (wisdom Buddhas), along with Vairocana, Amitabha, Ratnasambhava, and Amoghasiddhi. He is occasionally merged with Acala, a protective deity, particularly in Shingon traditions.

Akshobhya Buddha ("Immovable One") symbolizes the overcoming of passions such as anger and hatred towards other beings. He was given charge over the eastern paradise Abhirati. He is easily recognized in illustrations by having a blue body
